

SECTION I: WATERFRONT REVITALIZATION AREA BOUNDARY

TOWN OF HASTINGS WATERFRONT REVITALIZATION AREA BOUNDARY

The landward boundary of the Waterfront Revitalization Area within the Town of Hastings, illustrated by the continuous red line beginning at the intersection of Chesbro Road and County Route 33,

- then in a southern direction, the boundary follows the Town limits until it reaches the Oneida river;
- then in a southeastern direction, the boundary follows the municipal edges until it reaches the boarder to West Monroe;
- then in a nothern direction the boudary goes approximately 2 miles north;
- then in a westernly direction the boundary follows Gildner Road, following it south with the curve to the road;
- then at approximately 280 feet from County Route 37 the boundary goes in a northwesternly direction, following the curve of the road;
- then approximately 500 feet from County Route 12 the boudary goes a slight northeastern direction for appriximatley 500 feet, crossing County Route 12;
- then in a slight southwesternly direction the boundary follows County Route 12 until the Caughdenoy volunteer fire department on prospect street;
- then in a northwesternly direction the boundary travels behind the the fire department;
- then in a western direction the boundary follows the path to propect street until 72 Prospect Street;
- the boundary then goes in a northern direction for approximately 60 feet;
- then in a northeastern direction the boundary follows prospect street until it intersects County Route 33;
- then in a northwestern direction the boundary follows County Route 33 until it meets the starting point.
