The Town of Hastings will be hosting a public presentation to discuss the Draft County Route 37 (CR-37) Flood and Drainage Study. The project is funded in part through the NYS Department of Homeland Security and Emergency Services (DSHES) Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP). The purpose of the study is to evaluate the conditions that have resulted in flooding along CR-37 primarily between Camic Road and Bradbury Road. The goals of the study are to:

- Assess risk and vulnerability of the community, including residential areas vulnerable to ongoing localized flooding, based on updated hydrologic & hydraulic assessments;
- Integrate the information and goals outlined in the Oswego County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan related to disaster recovery and mitigation of recurring localized flooding;
- Evaluate potential amendments to existing ordinances, or adoption of new ordinances, which promote reduction of flooding risk and increased resiliency in future development.

The Town's consultant, Barton & Loguidice, will provide a review and analysis of the contributing drainage area and associated hydrologic and hydraulic analyses. The Draft Report will be summarized including topics related to:

- Site reconnaissance findings
- Assessment of the contributing drainage area
- Evaluation of land use changes and drainage modifications within the study area
- Summary of hydrologic and hydraulic modeling
- Identification of potential causes of increased instances of localized flooding;
- Flood inundation mapping
- Identification of at-risk infrastructure
- Recommendations for next steps
